211 New Church Road, Hove, BN3 4ED

Due to the increase in regular users of Church House, Hove in recent years and in particular the high demand for meeting rooms, we have had to review our approach to car parking.

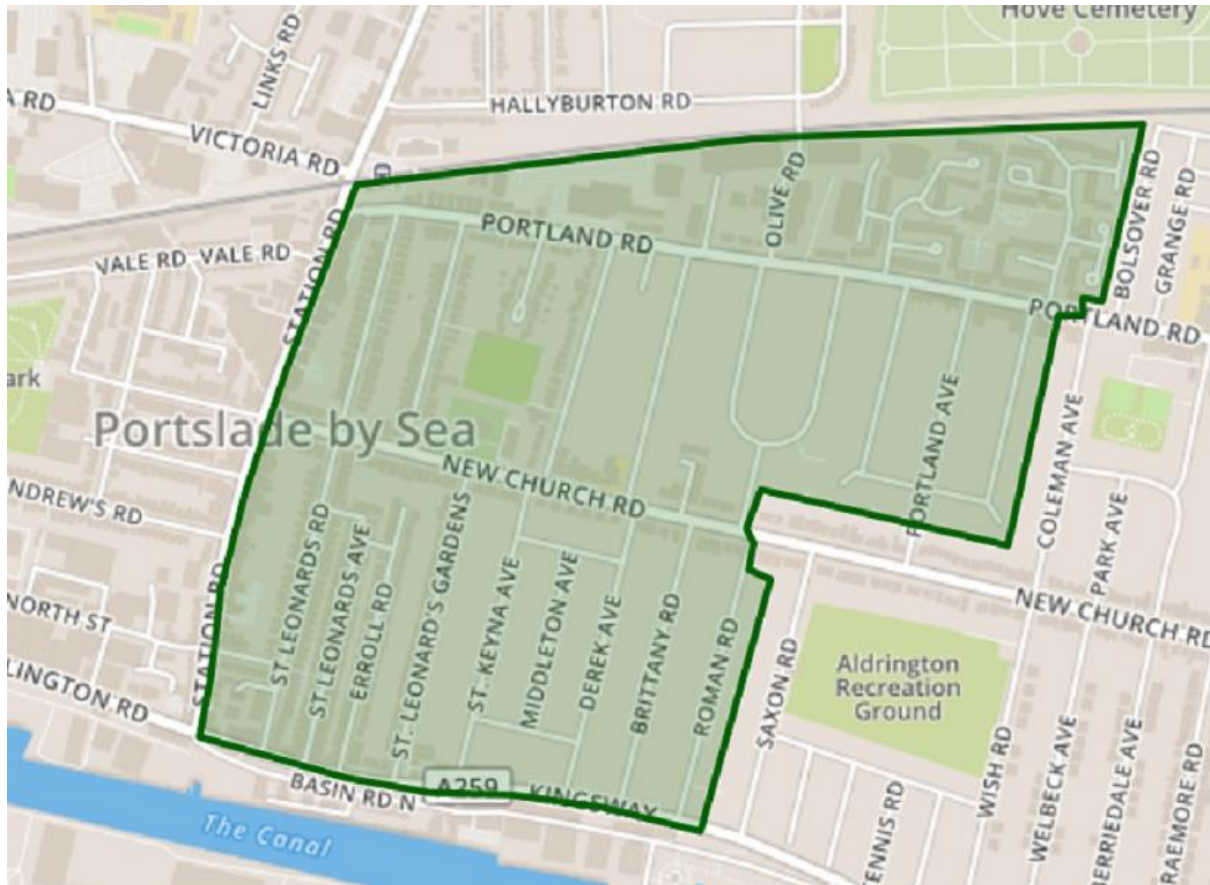
Regrettably, because of the limited space available, we are unable to guarantee that parking spaces will be available for all staff and visitors. We would therefore encourage both staff and visitors to use public transport or to car share wherever possible. We would also encourage staff who know they will not need to move their car until the end of the working day to park at the rear of the building, where double parking can most easily be used if necessary.

If you have a particular health or logistical need and require an accessible car parking space, please do not hesitate to contact the front of office staff on 01273 421021 or adminhelpdesk@chichester.anglican.org and a space can be reserved for you.

It is possible to “double park” if a particular need arises. If you wish to use this system, please alert the front of house staff to seek guidance on where best to double park, and make sure they know where you are at all times, so that you can be asked to move if necessary and enable the person you have blocked in to leave.

Parking around Church House, Hove

Church House is in Parking Zone L, shown below. Permit bays operate Monday to Sunday, 11am to noon and 6pm to 7pm including Bank Holidays. There is no pay & display parking in this parking zone



Zone borders on this map are approximate. Always check street signs before you park.

Roads included in Parking Zone L :

Roads leading North from New Church Road to Portland Road:

Worcester Villas, Leicester Villas, Glebe Villas, Portland Villas, Rothbury Road, Jesmond Road, Mansfield Road & Woodhouse Road.

Roads North of Portland Road:

Olive Road & Ingram Cr W & Ingram Cr E

Roads leading South from New Church Road to Kingsway (A259):

St Leonard's Road, St Leonard's Ave, Erroll Road, St Leonard's Gardens, St Keyna Ave, Kenton Road, Middleton Ave, Derek Ave, Brittany Road & Roman Road

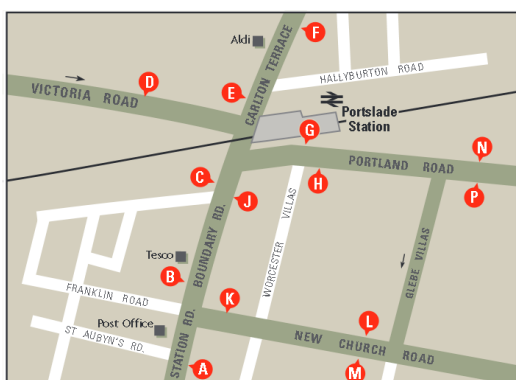
Getting to Church House

Train

Portslade Station has frequent train services to Brighton, Chichester, Littlehampton and London. Church House is within walking distance down Boundary Road (Portslade's High Street) and about 600 yards along New Church Road.

Bus

From Brighton Station the number 6 bus goes from Stop C outside the station. It runs at a rate of 4 or 5 an hour during the day, Monday to Saturday. If you want to spend out on a text (full cost not known) for details of the next bus due, text briajdm to 84268. The bus destination will be Downs Park and you want the St Keyna Avenue stop M. That is opposite Church House.

Road

The easiest approach by road from most parts of the diocese is via the A27 Brighton/Hove By-Pass. Use the A293 towards Portslade; turn left on to the A270 Old Shoreham Road and then immediately right at the next traffic lights. After the level crossing, New Church Road is the second on the left, at traffic lights. Church House is about 600 yards along New Church Road, next to St Leonard's Aldrington church.
